Wednesday, December 4: Depart for Washington, DC, with rest stops and lunch on your own en route. Arrive and visit the **Hillwood Estate, and Museum and Gardens** for a guided tour of the mansion in it's holiday splendor. Glamorous Christmas trees and festive decor await you at every turn! Spend time in the formal gardens and greenhouse to see Christmas greenery, such as blue atlas cedar decorated with bright holly and witch hazel. After, settle in at the **Washington National Cathedral** for *Evensong*. Check-in to the **Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center** and spend the rest of the evening at your leisure enjoying everything the Gaylord has to offer, including nightly indoor snowfalls, the region's most beautiful Christmas decorations with thousands of twinkling lights and a 55-foot tall Starlight Christmas tree. Dinner will be on your own, with free time to shop at the **National Harbor**.

Dinner will be at **Tony and Joe's** on the waterfront in Georgetown, before a trip to **Washington DC's Temple Visitors' Center Festival of Lights**. A live nativity scene, with live musical performances and over 250,000 lights and tree displays awaits you at this wonderful ode to Christmas.

Friday, December 6: Check-out of the hotel and visit the **NEW Museum of the Bible**. This new state-of-the-art 420,000 square foot facility conveys the global impact and compelling history of the Bible in a unique and powerful way. Lunch will be enjoyed on your own as you explore.
