Tour Details

Thursday, September 19: Depart for the **Adirondacks**, with a rest stop and lunch on your own en route. Arrive at **Lake George** for an afternoon boat cruise on beautiful Lake George, a lovely introduction to this scenic region. The **47th Annual Adirondack Balloon Festival** will kick off at Glens Falls' Crandall Park and Glen Street with a celebration featuring opening ceremonies, lively entertainment, food vendors, a car show, and the unforgettable sight of a medley of balloons taking off. Dinner will be at a local restaurant before check-in at the hotel.

Friday, September 20: Breakfast is included each morning at the hotel. Depart for the **Adirondack Experience, the Museum on Blue Lake**, where you will explore people's connections to the Adirondacks through interactive exhibits, hands-on activities, and culturally rich collections. After, journey east to Lake Champlain's southernmost point and **Fort Ticonderoga**, the scene of two wars and five battles. At the fort, interact with guides costumed in early 19th Century garb and watch re-enactors practice military drills and trades in and around the Fort. This evening we gather for dinner at a local restaurant in the Lake George area.

Saturday, September 21: Check-out of the hotel. This morning attend the **gala balloon ascension and festivities at the 47th Annual Adirondack Balloon Festival**. You have the opportunity to take a hot air balloon ride to enjoy the sights and beauty of the Adirondacks, or choose to observe from the ground below. Free time for lunch on your own, shopping and sightseeing in the quaint downtown area of Lake George. Depart for home with a rest stop and dinner on your own en route.
