Tour Details

Sunday, October 13: Depart for Winchester, VA, with a rest stop and lunch on your own at Country Cupboard. Arrive and check-in at the hotel. Travel to the **George Washington Hotel** for dinner. After, enjoy the musical performance of a **Patsy Cline Tribute Singer**.

Monday, October 14: Breakfast included each morning at the hotel. Check-out and board the train for a scenic ride along the **Potomac Eagle Scenic Railroad**. Enjoy a narrated excursion through a tranquil and pristine mountain valley. View historic farms and lush mountain greenway. Don't be surprised to see bald eagles swooping overhead in pursuit of prey or gliding gently across the blue mountain skies. Arrive at the **Cumberland Depot** to board the **Western Maryland Railroad**. Climb through the spectacular scenery of the Allegheny Mountains with lunch included on the train. Check-in to the **Isaac Jackson Hotel**. Later, arrive at the **Gandy Dancer Dinner Theater** for a dinner performance by the **Mountain Memories Show Band**. This high energy, family-friendly variety show is filled with comedy and music.

Tuesday, October 15: This morning, board the **Cheat Mountain Salamander** for a ride through the wild, high-mountain wilderness of West Virginia. Enjoy the view in the comfort of the train's climate-controlled passenger cars, with a photo stop at **High Falls**. Arrive at **Station 2** for lunch, with free time to shop and browse at the **Rail to Trail Store**. After, board the **Durbin Rocket** for another exciting mountain rail expedition. The coal-fired train pulls an authentic 1920s-era coach car and vintage wooden cabooses along the free-flowing Greenbrier River and through the Monongahela National Forest. Dinner this evening will be at **The RailYard Restaurant**, with the evening musical performance at the **Randolph Art Center**.

Wednesday, October 16: Check-out of the hotel and travel to Altoona, PA with a rest-stop en route. Lunch will be on your own before a self-guided tour of the **Railroaders Memorial Museum**. Depart for home with a rest stop and dinner on your own en route.
